The 2004 J. Lynne Pinot Noir was made from grapes grown on the Cameron Ranch in the Russian River Valley in Sonoma County, California. These hand selected grapes were left on the vine late into the growing season to ensure maximum varietal flavors.

J. Lynne Pinot Noir has delightful aromas of strawberry and lavender. Delicate flavors of Bing cherries complement the lingering, silky finish.

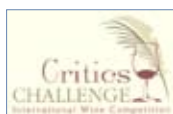
