The wine competition, held in Santa Rosa, California is now in its 35th year; it began in 1974 with 59 entries and it broke a record this year with 1,214, all produced from Sonoma County grapes.

There were 32 entries in the "Sonoma County Pinot Noir: Up to \$24.99" category; 2007 J. Lynne Two Vineyard Pinot Noir was the only Russian River Valley Pinot Noir in this category to garner a GOLD MEDAL.

Awards were announced during the 2009 Harvest Fair Awards Night Gala.

"This Pinot Noir is 100% varietal, appellation and vintage," commented winemaker Jennifer Wall. "J. Lynne Pinot Noir comes from two vineyards located in the heart of the Russian River Valley: the Wes Cameron Ranch (54%) and Saralee's Vineyard (46%). These vineyards are located only a few miles from each other."

"The grapes that became J. Lynne Pinot Noir were hand selected, de-stemmed and cold soaked prior to fermentation; only French oak barrels were used," stated Wall. "My wines are crafted to be true to the varietal and region. This wine is light, elegant and rich at the same time."

2007 has proved to a banner vintage for J. Lynne Pinot Noir. This wine was recommended in 2 issues of Wine & Spirits magazine, which gave it 91 Points and 5 stars. It has also garnered gold medals from other competitions as well.

Less than 1000 cases were produced.
